

YOUR PICK UP DAY MAY CHANGE!

*The City of Jefferson is switching curbside garbage collection companies. The new company, Advanced Disposal, will be going to a five-day per week pick up schedule. Therefore, your pick up day may change. Starting December 19, 2018, we will begin swapping out your Waste Pro carts and bins and replacing them with Advanced Disposal Containers. This process will last approximately 3 weeks. You will need to put your garbage out on your normally scheduled day along with **ALL** extra carts and recycle bins during this time. Please put your can out by 6:00 am on your pick up day and leave out until 6:00 pm. Even though your garbage may be collected early, please leave your can out until 6:00 pm. Do not be alarmed if your can is not replaced immediately. Again, this process will last approximately 3 weeks.*

Your new container will have a cart hanger with information regarding your **NEW PICK UP DAY**. You may log on to our website for more information at www.cityofjeffersonga.com and go to Public Works.

Beverage Cans

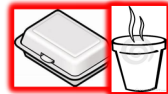


RECYCLE WRONG
